Ronald Ortiz, proprietor of the Radio Hut on Poplar St., has been contracted to liquidate all the old radios, many of which will be disassembled and sold as parts.

*"The parts are sometimes more valuable than the radio itself"* said Mr. Ortiz. Especially valuable are the CC317 chips, which are used in the radios being liquidated. ComCo no longer manufactures those chips, but they are prized by amateur CB radio enthusiasts for their sturdy design and long life.

## "Big Red" Missile Silo to be Decommissioned

The International Cooperative Military Complex is decommissioning an ACM Missile, fondly nicknamed "Big Red". At Silo #1, the nuclear warhead will be separated and driven 4 miles to the air transit terminal where it will be loaded onto an undisclosed aircraft for transport to a secure disposal facility. Security will be tighter than usual, due to the inherently risky process, and especially after the Russia incident when the Stay for Judgment terror organization nearly got their hands on an aging warhead.

Although the ACM Cruise Missile is over 20 feet in length, weighing over 3,700 lbs, the W80 warhead is small enough to fit in the trunk of a car. That is, of course, not how they plan on transporting the warhead to the disposal facility. The missile separation will begin at 7:00PM tonight.
